Physical Survey

- Can be attached to the newspaper they have every month
- Traditional surveys are more friendly to them
- EHDOC can hand out surveys at their event

What we can get from the survey

- Give us the current status of the use of technology by the elderly
- How they want to learn new technology
- What new technologies do they want to learn





Research Methodology

Stakeholders meeting and online references:

- Conducted meetings with the stakeholders to identify their problems and how we can address them using this survey.
- Reviewed online materials for similar kinds of surveys to identify the challenges they faced.
- Developed questions based on this research.

The BIGGER question: Willingness to adopt technology?

• The biggest question that arose during our research phase was: Is there a willingness within the elderly population to adopt the technology?



DEVELOPING THE SURVEY

Focus group sessions:

- Conducted focus group sessions involving older adults within the EHDOC organization during our weekly meetings.
- Shortlisted the questions to include in the final survey based on the responses from the elderly's in the focus group session.

Survey Formatting:

- Single paged survey with enough spacing and easily readable text.
- Accessible via multiple formats
- Including an Introduction/Overview paragraph in the newsletter version.

DATA EXTRACTION AND ANALYSIS

How we compiled it into the database:

- Received the survey results as PDF's from Tracy and Paul
- Extracted raw data to excel sheet
- Converted raw data in to string, binary and numerical data

How we analyzed the data:

- Binary data was aggregated in to percentages
- Average of numerical data was calculated and adjusted

- 68% of the elderly have a smartphone
- 84% of the elderly use devices to stay connected with friends and family

- Interest in using technology to stay connected is the highest among all choices, followed by healthcare
- High willingness (2.9/4) to learn a new, provided device
- Above average willingness (2.4/4) to learn new apps
- Individual's Interest in learning technology are skewed to the extremes elders were either extremely interested in learning technology or not at all

- The younger elderly (60-70) are significantly more willing to learn more about technology than the older elderly (80-90)
- The younger elderly (60-70) are more interested in using technology for **online shopping**, **banking**, and **information/education**
- Elderly who don't understand English well are interested in having their devices translated for them
