


### What is WAND




### **Key Finding 1 - Awareness**

How knowledgeable are you about the 1033 program?



4. How did you hear about the 1033 program?





### **Key Finding 2- Overall Public Opinion**

We found:


- 36 % of respondents think society is safer with the 1033 program
- 37% of respondents think the 1033 program is necessary for citizens safety



### **Public Opinion based on political identity**


### Conservative

- 36% of conservative leaning respondents think society is safe with the 1033 program
- 40 % of conservative leaning respondents think the 1033 program is necessary for



### Liberal

- 40% of liberal leaning respondents think society is safe with the 1033 program
- 44% of liberal leaning respondents think the 1033 program is necessary for safety



## Key Finding 3- Overall Attitude Change

We found:

- A change in opinion between questions 8 and 13
- 40% of respondents now oppose the 1033 program




#### To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statements?


# Attitude Change based upon political identity

We found:


• 27% of conservative respondents now oppose the 1033 program



# Suggestions to raise awareness

- 1. Analyze how people get their news
  - a. Television & Online News outlets
  - b. Podcasts are very relevant now
- 1. Target age audience
  - a. 16-34 yr olds: Social Media 55-65 yr olds: Television
  - a. Conservatives or Liberals

16-24 years old: 20.1 percent more likely to answer "Social Media"

- 55-65 years old: 17.5 percent more likely to answer "Television"
- 25-34 years old: 10.9 percent more likely to answer "Social Media"

### **Suggestions to raise awareness (part 2)**


Four statements about the 1033 program to test their impact

- 1. The Department of Defense does not provide training for law enforcement agencies that receive controlled property.
- 2. The distribution of military-grade controlled items increases police violence.
- 3. Military-grade weapons transfers do not actually reduce crime.
- 4. The Government Accountability Office was able to create a fake police department and receive approximately \$1.2 million in controlled military items.


### **Sample Messages**

- Between Questions 7 and 13

  - Comparison of their results to get insight on the influence of the statements

#### To what extent do you support or oppose legislation banning the transfer of military-grade weapons to law enforcement?




- Significant spike in strong support

  - Effective messaging





### Sample Messages: Political Partisanship

- Originally more support
- Spike in support but not for strong opposition








### Sample Messages: Political Partisanship


- Individuals identifying as Republicans
  - Rise in agreement
  - Opposition decreasing
- Proof that the messaging is at least somewhat effective

To what extent do you support or oppose legislation banning the transfer of military-grade weapons to law enforcement?









## Sample Message: Age groups

# Mostly similar patterns all across groups

- Rise in support and decrease in opposition
- Exception is 55-65 year olds for which opposition rose
- Highest support from 55-65 year olds originally but 25-44 after the sample messages




To what extent do you support or oppose legislation banning the transfer of military-grade weapons to law enforcement?





### Sample Messages: Gender

# Similar trends for both genders

- Slightly higher spike of strong support for women
- Minimal decrease of strong opposition for both genders
- Biggest difference for somewhat oppose









### Sample Messages: Voting Habits

# Rise of support for all groups

- Significant increase of support for regular voters and non-voters
- No particular pattern for any of the groups

### Limitations

Lack of diversity in the respondent pool

- 0 75.8% of White respondents
- 0 16.7% of Black or African American respondents
  - All others under 5%

Message testing difficult through surveys

- Extracted knowledge is limited
- Hard to control
- More suited to focus groups
