




1 in 4 Northeastern Students Go Hungry

That is 3x the rate of food insecurity in Massachusetts.

Over 300 students—mostly graduate and international—regularly use the NU Mutual Mobile Food Pantry.

What is YDSA Doing?

Started democratically led No Hungry Huskies Campaign.

3,200 petition signatures

2 campus marches

town hal

Daily tour storming



Petition Demands

- To achieve cost-per-swipe parity with Boston schools, NU meal plan costs need to be reduced by 24%
- Guarantee 3 meals/day for meal plan-required students;
- Make Swipe2Care automatic
- End food waste
- Meet demands of dining worker union



Progress So Far

- Expanded Swipe2Care from covering just undergraduate students to include graduate students
- Ended the ban on taking food from dining halls with the provision of free takeout boxes
- Meal recovery program (20-30 meals/day)
- Increase dining worker pay by \$9/hr through NU HOWL work
- Other stuff we can't share yet :)



Key Points of Success

- Democratic decision making process
- Developing a long term escalation strategy with increasingly intense tactics
- Using student government as an awareness raising tool
- Building a coalition of student groups
- Function Oriented Committees > Issue Committees
- Regular Progress Reflections
